Next Generation Science Standards and Implementation

Mrs. Jean Barbanente, Assistant Superintendent, shared the district is implementing changes to the science curriculum to align with the Next Generation Science Standards (NGSS). The Science department chairs, Erin Groth and Yvonne Tsagalis, presented and outlined the changes, which include the restructuring and reorganization of units, creation of six common assessments and conclusion writing. The NGSS model is a hands-on approach so students can make their own observations. Biology is currently using the NGSS and is seeing good results. Chemistry will be implemented in 2015-16 and Physics in 2016-17.
