## E-Rate Updates

Mr. Robert Flemming, Director of Business Services, presented information on the district's wireless access infrastructure. This project is part of a scheduled upgrade, which was reviewed by the Technology Committee. Three components of this infrastructure are: wireless access points and controllers; software, licensing, equipment and multi-year warranty; and professional service and support. By updating the wireless access system, it will improve Internet accessibility, increase coverage for more devices and access the network quicker, and provide faster access to web resources and Internet tools.
