Summer School Highlights

Dr. Adam Cibulka, Director of Curriculum, Instruction and Assessment, and Dr. Sam Bentsen, Director of Student Services, presented highlights from summer school. This year's focus areas were On-Track Graduation Programs, Credit Advancement Programs, Special Education Extended School Year Programs and STEM Summer Camp. As a result of these summer school programs, 260 credits were earned through our direct instruction and computer-based credit recovery programs, 89 students met their Speech graduation requirement, 26 students met the district requirement for Consumer Management, about 60 students participated in the Advanced Placement prep program, students continued receiving special education services and 87 students registered from District 4, 45, 48 and 88 for the STEM camp.

Credit Card Summary

Mr. Edward Hoster, Chief Financial Officer, reviewed the district's credit card use report for July 2017, as outlined in Board Policy 4:55 Use of Credit and Procurement Cards.

Preliminary Textbook Sales Analysis

Mr. Hoster shared the district has found an alternative to reduce the financial burden of our user-based system for instructional materials. The district allocated Title I grant funds to buy classroom sets and/or full text for students in courses having the highest-cost materials. The preliminary analysis shows the average reduction of textbook sales per student went from \$165 to \$103. The highest cost paid was reduced to \$511 from \$699. Of those who paid \$350 or more, the count declined from 144 to only 17 students.
