PARCC Assessments

Mrs. Barbanente informed the Board that in spring 2015, students taking English 11 and Algebra 2/Advanced Algebra will participate in PARCC testing. District 88 students will continue to participate in ACT/EPAS testing with a few modifications. The District administration has decided to eliminate fall testing for freshmen and sophomores. Juniors will continue to take a Practice ACT in the fall.

ACT Profile

Mrs. Barbanente highlighted key points of the 2014 ACT Profile for District 88, as well as school reports for Addison Trail and Willowbrook. These scores are from the 2014 graduating class who tested in the spring-fall of 2013. The scores include all ACT test takers, including those with accommodations and English Language Learners.
