# **BUILDING THE FUTURE IN DISTRICT 88:**

**Dr. Steve Humphrey** indicated that visible signs of the project are underway with the arrival of the construction trailer on the Willowbrook campus this week and Addison Trail's scheduled to arrive next month. He invited the community to participate in **groundbreaking celebrations on June 1** at 1:30 for ATHS and 4:00 p.m. for WBHS. The bids were recently released and **construction is scheduled to begin the week of June 9** following the graduation ceremonies.

### **DISCUSSION ITEMS:**

- Mrs. Jean Barbanente, Director of Learning Services, presented information about the staffing trends for the 2008-2009 school year for both schools. Staffing for the 2008-2009 school year will include an increase of 9.9 Certified Staff (including all new and grant funded positions) as compared to staffing numbers from the spring staffing for the 2007-2008 school year.
- The District 88 Technology Committee discussed the topic of changing current purchasing procedures for technology in light of the complexities, volume and time constraints of the Building The Future project. Discussion focused on changing from a bid process to a multiple quote process. Further discussion will take place during the May Board meetings.
