The tentative tax levy for 2011 was reviewed and approved at the November 7, 2011, Regular Business Board Meeting. At that time, the Board adopted a resolution to establish the aggregate amount of taxes estimated to be levied for the year 2011 in the amount of \$48,969,605. No changes or updates were made since the tentative tax levy was approved in November. In compliance with the Truth in Taxation Law, the public hearing was opened for Board members and audience members to ask questions and discuss the 2011 proposed tax levy.

- NCLB Update on Grade 11 Definition

Mandated by the Illinois School Code, changes to the grade 11 definition that will take place this spring include administering the Prairie State Achievement Examination (PSAE) or the Illinois Alternate Assessment (IAA) to students with; junior status by virtue of credits earned. Students will not be promoted to grade 12 status until they have taken either the PSAE or IAA, as applicable. This will also impact student status for other school-related activities where year in school is listed and credits earned determine year in school.
