#### Newsweek/Washington Post

Dr. Scott Helton, Superintendent of Schools, shared Addison Trail and Willowbrook have been named as "Top High Schools" by Newsweek and as "America's Most Challenging High Schools" by The Washington Post. Addison Trail and Willowbrook ranked in the top 735 schools nationwide for 2014 by Newsweek and ranked in the top 6 percent of U.S. public high schools for 2014 by The Washington Post. This is the second consecutive year both schools have received both honors in the same year.

This program annually recognizes and honors people who have made outstanding contributions to public and nonpublic elementary and secondary education. #### Educational Focus Items for September 22, 2014

The Educational Focus Items for the September 22 Board meeting will include Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) Initiatives, Social/Emotional Interventions and Programming as well as Parent Programs for the year.

#### Ombudsman PLUS Program Update

Mrs. Jean Barbanente, Assistant Superintendent, reported the facility housing the Ombudsman PLUS program, a joint venture between District 88 and Glenbard District 87, is open and designed to be our own special education outside placement facility, which will provide a local, cost-effective and higher-quality option to better meet the needs of our students. The program is using District 88's curriculum. An appreciation for such a program in the district has been expressed.

#### Transition Program Update

Mrs. Barbanente shared a number of local businesses have joined our Vocational Education Program that helps students with diverse needs obtain job training and gain work experience. The vision is for the students to gain independence in the workplace. Businesses are asked to complete a checklist evaluation each semester. Participating employers have reported positive customer feedback.

#### Freedom of Information Request

The following Freedom of Information request was received and fulfilled.

#### A request from Mr. Jake Griffin, Daily Herald Senior Writer, for:

- A list or documents sufficient to show the age and grade level of students disciplined with suspension from team or group activities, along with the number of days suspended and what teams and/or school-sanctioned organized group activities a student was suspended from, for violating the school district's athletic department and/or districtwide student drug and alcohol abuse/use policies for the school years: 2013-14; 2012-13; and 2011-12.
- The number of students enrolled at the district for the above listed school years.

Mrs. Barbanente explained how we took great caution in our response. The District did not want to provide information that would identify any students.

#### **Budget Preparation Update**

Mr. Edward Hoster, Chief Financial Officer, said progress is being made to finalize the budget since the tentative budget was put on file in June 2014. With adjustments/changes being made to staffing, revenue sources and the closing of two TIFs in Addison, it is difficult to predict how much the net change will be to our initial projected deficit. Hearing and adoption of said Budget is set for September 22, 2014. District 88 is working to improve on the budgeting methodology involving contingencies to ensure this budget is as representative of the financial resources needed for 2014-15.
