ESSA Update

Superintendent Dr. Scott Helton and Assistant Superintendent Jean Barbanente discussed updates regarding the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). With the ESSA draft proposal, the state is recommending several pathways for schools to define College and Career Readiness for its students.

In the ESSA draft proposal, the majority of the accountability will be attainment scores on the SAT, HS graduation rate, and EL proficiency. The remainder of the accountability measure will include pathways to College and Career Readiness, including measures such as GPA, AP enrollment and scores, dual credit coursework, workplace credentialing, community service, etc. The balanced accountability model focuses on the idea student success is “more than a score.”

Director of Curriculum, Instruction & Assessment Adam Cibulka presented an overview on PSAT/SAT and demonstrated the Khan Academy tutorials available to students.
