#### Credit Card Summary

Mr. Edward Hoster, Chief Financial Officer, reviewed the district's credit card use report for June 2015, as outlined in Board Policy 4:55 Use of Credit and Procurement Cards.

## Overview of 2014-15 Financial Report (Unaudited) as of June 20, 2015

Mr. Hoster presented the unaudited budget summary and analysis reports for the 2014-15 fiscal year. He provided information summarizing a comparison of "budget to actual" revenue and expenditures for 2014-15, reviewing the Operating Funds. The district completed the fiscal year with an operating funds deficit of \$240,834.

#### Health/Life Safety Amendments

Mr. Hoster reported the Illinois State Board of Education (ISBE) has provided its final approval of District 88's 10-year health/life safety amendments for all three locations. The revised total of all work approved and required to be completed is \$499,560, which represents a decrease of \$4.1 million. The ISBE agreed the electrical distribution system work at both buildings is necessary, but this work does not meet the criteria to be funded with the health/life safety resources. The district will begin to coordinate the completion of this corrective work.





## <u>Technology Overview of Summer Projects</u>

Dr. Aaron Lenaghan, Director of Technology, Teaching & Learning, gave an overview of the technology summer projects. In particular, increasing wireless access points for both schools, expansion of Chromebooks, online pre-registration options for parents, online learning opportunities for students and upgrades to software.

- More than 1,000 students participated in 24 summer athletic camps. The first day of fall sports was Aug. 12.
- ♣ The Athletic BBQ and Code of Conduct meeting took place on Aug. 12.

- Open House will take place on Sept. 3, with tours at 5:30 p.m. and a parent meeting at 6:15 pm.

## **Willowbrook**

- More than 300 students participated in 10 summer school courses. More than 40 athletic camps for 20 different sports took place this summer.
- Registration took place during the week of Aug. 10. Twenty-five percent of the student population completed pre-registration online.
- ♣ As of Aug. 17, there are 2,013 students enrolled.
- Last week kicked off the fall sports season. More than 500 students are participating in one of 11 fall sports. Good luck, Warriors!
- On Aug. 18, the Girls Golf Team kicks off the season with a tri-meet at Sugar Creek.
