# Graduation Report Presented to the Board

#### **EDUCATIONAL FOCUS ITEM:**

• Mrs. Jean Barbanente, Assistant Superintendent, highlighted the accomplishments of the District's graduates as well as progress towards increasing graduation rate. District 88 has achieved a graduation rate of 93% and is pleased with the increased performance by students and staff. In addition, Mrs. Barbanente presented an overview of the School Improvement process for the 2010-2011 school year. This process will focus on Curriculum, Assessment, Instructional Strategies, Behavior Intervention and Social Emotional Learning. The internal and external progress monitoring was also outlined.
