Educational Focus Items for October 26, 2015

Freedom of Information Requests

The following Freedom of Information requests were received and fulfilled:

A request from Mr. Patrick McCraney, Better Government Association, for:

- Collective Bargaining Agreements: Any and all current collective bargaining agreements, including, but not limited to, union contracts with teachers. If a union is currently operating under an expired contract, please include it.
- Administrator Contracts: Any and all employment/personnel agreements and contracts with current administrators, including, but not limited to, superintendents and principals.
- Budget: The approved operating and capital budgets for the 2015-16 school year.

- All Illinois School Report Cards listing graduation rates, from the first publicly available in 1998 to the most recent 2014. From 1998-2001, there is no breakdown of graduation rate by ethnicity available. From 2002-2014, graduation rates are broken down by ethnicity.
