#### Joint Committee/PERA Update

Mrs. Jean Barbanente, Assistant Superintendent, shared the progress toward the implementation of PERA. Significant change occurred during the last few years with regard to the teacher evaluation, including the process, timelines, and legal requirements. The Joint Committee, made up of both administration and union leadership, worked on the plan and piloted the professional practice portion this school year. The plan includes both formal, pre-scheduled, observations as well as informal, unannounced classroom visits. The PERA implementation is on track, and the committee will begin work on the student-growth component in August.
