At District 88, we have found that there are four specific areas that support successful transitions for students with IEP's. We have the Fabulous Four factors! Our vocational coordinator is available to assist families in navigating the transition process.

- 1. The Transition Plan: Be involved, be motivated and have a Vision
- 2. Determine the Needed Potential Student Supports Needed for after school
 - a. PUNS Support
 - i. Students with cognitive disabilities who may require higher level of support for success
 - b. DRS Support
 - i. Students who have the vision to be competitively employed
 - c. Other supports for Transportation and Living option
 - d. Post secondary supports for success in additional educational programs
- 3. Educate family regarding needed parent and family supports and resources
 - a. Guardianship
 - b. Special Needs Trusts
 - c. Financial programs
 - d. Social emotional supports
 - e. Next Steps Educational Program for Parents
- 4. Important Vocabulary
 - a. Entitlement
 - b. Eligibility
 - c. Availability
