THE DAY YOU REGISTER:

Please enter the building at **Door 5** to begin the registration process. Please remember to bring the following items on your assigned day:

- a. Each student should bring a pen to sign documents when necessary.
 - Cash or a signed, blank check(s) to pay for necessary books and fees. We also accept Visa and MasterCard for payment.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: District 88 will again offer a payment plan/interest-free student loan for textbooks and fees. A parent/guardian signature is required to begin a payment plan/loan with a minimum of \$100.00 deposit per student at the time of registration. Information on your student balance is available with Mrs. DiNatale, Bookstore Manager, at 630-628-3331. Please contact Mr.Bolden's office at 630-628-3306 if you should have any questions.

All loans from 2013 - 2014 must be paid before a new loan is issued.

c. A separate \$40.00 check (payable to Addison Trail High School) or cash is necessary if you wish to purchase a copy of the '14 -'15 yearbook. Please note the cost of the '14-'15 yearbook will increase to \$45.00 after November 1. HR Imaging Studios will also be present at registration to take underclassmen pictures for the yearbook. FRESHMEN & NEW STUDENTS TO ADDISON TRAIL:

Each student must file current health records; immunization records and a 9th grade physical examination with the **school nurse** prior to registration. If you have not completed this yet, please do so immediately to avoid problems during registration.

IMMUNIZATION NOTICE:

The Illinois Office of Education and the Illinois Department of Public Health request that parents and guardians be warned that students not in compliance with required levels of immunization will be excluded from school this fall.

Immunization requirements for high school age students are:

- a. Tetanus, diphtheria, acellular pertussis (Tdap) a basic series and booster after 2006.
- b. Polio A basic series of two oral doses with a booster after four years of age.
- c. Measles Children entering 9th grade for the first time after July of 1996, and entering any grade level after July of 1998, will be required to show evidence of having received two doses of live measles virus vaccine, the first dose at least 12 months of age and the second dose no less than 1 month after the first or other proof of immunity described in this part.
- d. Rubella Given after fifteen months of age.
- e. Mumps Given after fifteen months of age.
- f. HBV (Hepatitis B Vaccine) series of three vaccinations

I.D. CARDS:

All students will be required to purchase an I.D. card (cost \$3.00) for the 2014-15 school year. IDs lost during the school year will be replaced at a cost of \$3.00.

BUS ROUTE INFORMATION:

Bus Routes and pickup times will be available at registration. In addition, any student who is eligible to ride the bus will have a route number printed on his/her ID. If you should have any questions, please consult the enclosed Parent/Student Handbook for further information.

STUDENTS OWING MONIES:

Students owing the district monies from the previous school year for loans, library fines, lost classroom books, unpaid class fees, project supplies, safety glasses, etc., <u>may not be allowed to register</u> until these monies have been paid. Any money owed by the student may be paid <u>before</u> registration week by coming to the Bookstore during the hours of 7:30 A.M. to 3:30 P.M. Monday through Thursday, or 8:00 A.M. to 11:00 A.M. on Friday, prior to August 11th. If there are any questions, please call 628-3306.
