Proposed Learning Compact/Joint Resolution - Senate Bill 16

Dr. Scott Helton, Superintendent of Schools, reported Senate Bill 16 would have a negative impact on District 88 and its associate districts, which equates to a loss of nearly \$10 million a year. He said although the districts' local representatives are in opposition of the bill, a message needs to go to all representatives of the state. Therefore, he proposed District 88, in conjunction with districts 4, 45 and 48, approve the Joint Resolution opposing Senate Bill 16 during its next Board meeting.
