


WHO WE SERVE



FAMILY BRIDGES

- Family Bridges offers workshops, retreats and conferences for:
 - Families
 - Couples
 - Single adults
 - Parents
 - Students



COUPLES

- Couples receive 8 hours of relationship skills education in:
 - Communication
 - Problem-solving
 - Conflict resolution
 - Commitment
 - Safety in the relationship



SINGLES

Single adults practice the same relationship skills as couples plus:

- Partner selection.
- How to determine if this is the right person.
- How to slow down a relationship and get to know the person before committing.

- Full day conference for couples, teen and children.

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MENTORING: MARRIAGE CHAMPIONS

- Couples trained to help other couples have healthy, longlasting marriages that empower the family and strengthen the community.
- They may mentor engaged couples or those who would like enrichment.



LEADERSHIP TRAINING

- 8-week training in Spanish or English for volunteers to develop leadership skills and transform their community.
- Volunteers grow in the personal qualities under the values of hope, respect, honesty, unity, identity, and balance.

- Family Bridges believes that healthy relationships are not only important in the home, but also in the workplace.




PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT



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
A BETTER ME
