Is the AP exam optional or required?

Exams are optional, but students who take AP classes are strongly encouraged to take the exam. Students must earn a certain score on the exam to obtain college credit. How do I register to take an AP exam?

- At the AT Bookstore between **Monday, March 16, and Friday, March 27.**
- **The registration fee is \$91 per exam; students who miss the registration deadline will be charged a \$55 late fee.**
- Students who receive free or reduced lunch will have their testing registration fee waived.
