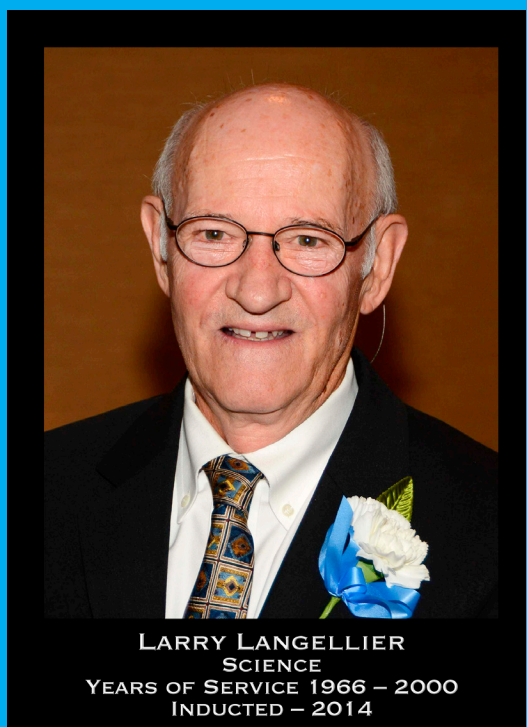
Accomplishments:
