#### Finding a Monologue

Students will need to obtain and memorize a 1-minute monologue. These should be age appropriate and can be from any source, including movies, children's poetry, plays, musicals, or television. You can also find great children's monologue books on Amazon or at the library. Some good sources for younger actors (ages 6-10) include *Cool Characters for Kids* by Janet B. Milstein, *Magnificent Monologues for Kids* by Chambers Stevens, *Famous Fantasy Character Monologues* by Rebecca Young, or *My First Monologue Book* by Kristen Dabrowski. Older Actors (ages 11-12) might find something in 101 Monologues for Middle School Actors by Rebecca Young; teen actors (ages 13-14) can find material in standard monologue books, as long as they select something that is age appropriate.
