Senior Warriors

The seniors on Willowbrook High School's boys tennis team were among the honorees at the Willowbrook Athletic Booster Club's Senior Athletic Banquet. All three of the pictured seniors, along with Jose Alcantara (not pictured), earned Academic All-Conference honors in the West Suburban Gold Conference during the 2022 spring season. Willowbrook posted a 7-7 record in dual meets during the season. The Warriors, who landed in third place in the conference standings, claimed first-place honors at their own eight-team District 88 Invitational. The team finished second at the Addison Trail Invitational.



Warriors receive special scholarships

Willowbrook High School's Athletic Booster Club presented its Senior Athletic Banquet near the end of the 2021-22 school year. The event featured the presentation of several awards and scholarships to student-athletes in the school's Class of 2022. Two members of Willowbrook's senior class—Izzy Manning and Cristian Lager—received the John Hamann Memorial Scholarship. The scholarship is named after John Hamann, a longtime Willowbrook teacher and coach. Hamann, who passed away in 2010, taught in the school's industrial technology department for 34 years. He was the head coach of Willowbrook's varsity boys golf team for 35 years. He also spent several years as the school's varsity boys basketball coach. His wife of 42 years—Jalaine Hamann (far left)—and their son Jim Hamann (a 1997 Willowbrook graduate, far right) presented the scholarships to Manning and Lager. Each recipient received a \$2,500 scholarship. Manning, Lager and several other members of the school's Class of 2022 were nominated for the scholarship by a Willowbrook coach. The nominees exemplified Hamann's characteristics, including patience, leadership, integrity and dedication to Willowbrook High School. Manning played multiple sports for the Warriors. She was a placekicker for the school's football team and a standout on the girls soccer team. Lager was a key member of the Warriors' football and boys track and field teams.
