

Minimum Qualifications

- MUST NOT BE LESS THAN 18 YEARS OF AGE
- SHALL POSSESS SUFFICIENT READING AND MATH SKILLS TO SATISFACTORILY COMPLETE ON-THE-JOB TRAINING AND RELATED TECHNICAL INSTRUCTION. A HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA OR GED IS RECOMMENDED.
- PHYSICALLY CAPABLE OF PERFORMING THE ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE APPRENTICESHIP PROGRAM.
- VALID DRIVER'S LICENSE AND PROOF OF RELIABLE TRANSPORTATION.
- MUST PASS A DRUG TEST
