

IN AN EMERGENCY, TAKE ACTION!



SECURE!

Get inside. Lock outside doors.

STUDENTS

- Stay inside the building (or reenter the building, if possible).
- Continue with business as usual.

ADULTS

- Bring everyone indoors.
- Lock the outside doors.
- Increase situational awareness.
- Account for all students and adults.
- Continue with business as usual.



HOLD!

Stay in your room or area. Clear the halls.

STUDENTS

- Clear the hallways.
- Remain in your present room or area, until the “all clear” is announced.
- Continue with business as usual.

ADULTS

- Close and lock the door.
- Account for all students and adults.
- Continue with business as usual.



EVACUATE!

A location might be specified.

STUDENTS

- Leave items behind, if necessary.
- If possible, bring your phone with you.
- Follow instructions that are provided.

ADULTS

- Account for all students and adults.
- Notify authorities/administrators if any student/adult is missing or injured, or if you have an extra student/adult in your group.



SHELTER/SEVERE WEATHER!

STUDENTS

- Use the appropriate safety strategy for the respective hazard (see the chart below).

Hazard	Safety strategy
Tornado -	Evacuate to shelter area.
Hazmat -	Seal the room.
Earthquake -	Drop, cover and hold.
Flooding -	Get to high ground.

ADULTS

- Lead the appropriate safety strategy for the respective hazard (see the chart below).
- Account for all students and adults.
- Notify authorities/administrators if any student/adult is missing or injured, or if you have an extra student/adult in your group.



ACTIVE THREAT!

Run, hide, fight. BluePoint Alert Solutions might be activated.

Run/escape, if possible. Hide and/or barricade, if escape is not possible. Fight, as a last resort.

STUDENTS

- Follow instructions provided by adults to do what's best for your situation.
- If no adults are present, use your best judgment to be safe.

ADULTS

- Assess the threat.
- Instruct students on the best course of action.
